

# Genetics Working Party

The Genetics Working Party was been re-established in early summer 2015.

## Membership

The full membership has not been completed but co-opted members will be drawn from outside the organisation as appropriate

## Remit

The broad remit of the reactivated Working Party will be to provide a mechanism for continuing responsibility for

1. Clinical governance oversight of developments in clinical genetics
2. Multidisciplinary forum for review of haemophilia genetic services
3. Collaboration with the Haemophilia Laboratory Network
4. Audit of clinical and laboratory genetic services
5. Oversight, with Data Management Committee, of mutation data on NHD
6. Supporting thrombogenomics developments

Although the detailed remit has yet to be decided by the GWP at the first meeting, it is envisaged that it will meet relatively infrequently, once or twice per year, to provide the oversight elements and multidisciplinary forum that is required to support laboratory genetic services and ensure the continued developing interactions with more formal clinical genetic services including UKGTN.
