Von Willebrand disease

- from theory to clinical practice

An international, case-oriented course for physicians
in need of further training in VWD

20-22 April 2016, Malmö, Sweden

The 3-day course will begin with an introduction of VWD through a series of overview lectures. Thereafter, clinical cases will be presented and the management, prognosis, treatment and diagnosis of the disease will be discussed. The course will use an evidence-based approach and participants will review and present scientific articles about VWD.

International guidelines for the management of VWD will be distributed. Participants will receive a course binder including the guidelines, articles and lectures, i.e. "take home messages".

The course is a collaboration between Malmö Centre for Thrombosis and Haemostasis, Lund University, Skåne University Hospital and Octapharma AG.

LIPUS (Institute for the Professional Development of Physicians in Sweden) will review the course (www.lipus.se). CME (Continuing Medical Education) application pending.

Clinical experience of von Willebrand care is required as well as good English-speaking skills.
