Remit

This is a new group established to inform and guide the development of an updated Haemtrack system. We have a diverse membership that has expanded over the past 12 months, to include representation from all Haemtrack stakeholders. The group has met via a series of videoconferences to review the current Haemtrack system; areas for development, including usability and new functions; and to devise baseline requirements for the launch of Haemtrack 4.0 which is due to be released in the first quarter of 2022. The initial specification for Haemtrack 4.0 will also be informed by wider feedback collected via a questionnaire, devised by the group and distributed to all Haemtrack users. Haemtrack 4.0 will be a much more versatile system that can be easily updated and will be responsive to evolving user requirements, which the group hope to continue to inform. Over the coming months, the focus of the group will be to publicise the launch of Haemtrack 4.0 and to encourage users to switch from older versions of the system.
